1. Welcome and Introduction by Councillor Derek Finnis – Chairman.

Councillors and clerk briefly introduced themselves and their role on the Parish Council.

Councillor Finnis started the meeting by thanking the volunteers and all their efforts helping the vulnerable and assisting with the Reeves bread delivery during the lockdown last year.

Lastly, he thanked Councillors Heaven and Smart, who have decided to retire from the Parish Council – their hard work and vast knowledge has been appreciated by both the Parish Council and Britford village.

2. Public Session.

- a. Mr D. Moulard: Would like to know who is responsible for grass cutting and keeping The Green area tidy.

- b. Mr D Moulard: It has been noted across The Navigation a tree which has fallen across the bank and hindering the water flow – who is responsible for clearing this.

This is the landowner's responsibility and hopefully will be cleared during the summer months.

- c. Mrs Dodd: Litter has become an issue in Britford and is on the increase. The car park area of Britford Memorial and Community Hall has had a vast increase in volume of litter being left.

Councillor Clewer gave a summary of Wiltshire Council plans for the coming future. The focus is High Streets and getting people back into the City Centre. Also, the needs of the A36 and a by-pass will be looked at and how congestion issues will be addressed. Later in the year, because of the Wiltshire Council Local Plan Review Consultations developments will be looked at again.
